	<p>The course will offer students a structured and systematic revision of the essential GCSE topic areas, vocabulary and grammar and to practise listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in preparation for the summer examinations.</p> <p>Target language will be used where appropriate in order to consolidate the students' awareness of the rubrics they will face in the examination. A good lexical knowledge is essential in the various tasks. As a consequence, particular attention is given to the revision of key vocabulary and grammar related to the topic areas listed below.</p> <p>The following grammar will be covered: Adjectives (gender/number agreement, position, comparisons); verbs (present, perfect, imperfect, future etc); prepositions, conjunctions, time; sentence structure (for more advanced students); conditional and if clauses; prepositions, conjunctions, time. The list is not limited to this.</p> <p>Students are set past papers on a daily basis, so that they practise their skills in exam-style conditions, focusing on the techniques needed to deal with the specific tasks set at GCSE level.</p>
